Transport Canada Minimum Requirement

Age:	14 Minimum. It is recommended that the student be at least 16 must be 17 at issuance
Medical Fitness:	Category 1 or 3
Knowledge:	40 hours of Ground School

Obtain a minimum overall mark of 60% on the Transport Canada written examination (PPHEL) of 100 questions with a minimum of 60% obtained in each of the following 4 sections:

Air Law
Meteorology
Navigation
General Knowledge

Experience: Minimum of 45 hours of flight training as per Transport Canada

Training shall include:

17 hours dual flight instruction including:

Minimum of 3 hours of cross-country flight time

Minimum of 5 hours of instrument training (three may be in our approved Flyit simulator)

12 hours solo flight time including:

Minimum of 5 hours of cross-country flight time with the cross country of not less than 100 nautical miles from the point of departure with 2 full stop landing at points other than the point of departure.

Pass a flight test off approximately 1.5 hours. Transport Canada flight test will test both your flight maneuvers and your knowledge on the ground.

Training shall include:

55 hours dual flight instruction including:

Minimum of 5 hours of cross-country flight time

Minimum of 10 hours of instrument training (5 may be in our approved Flyit simulator)

35 hours solo flight time including:

Minimum of 10 hours of cross-country flight time with the cross country of not less than 2 hours flight time from the point of departure with 3 full stop landing at points other than the point of departure.

Pass a flight test off approximately 1.5 hours. Transport Canada flight test will test both your flight maneuvers and your knowledge on the ground.
