



# Commercial Pilot License Alternate Category

Must have commercial fixed wing license

## Transport Canada Minimum Requirement

Age:	14 Minimum. It is recommended that the student be at least 16. Candidate must be 18 at the time of License issuance.
Medical Fitness:	Category 1
Knowledge:	20 hours of Ground School

## Topics Include

Canadian Air Regulations  
Theory of Flight  
Meteorology  
Airframes, Engines and Aircraft Systems  
Flight Instruments  
Navigation  
Flight Operations  
Human Factors and Pilot Decision Making

Obtain a mark of 60% on the Transport Canada written examination of 35 questions. (PHRAC)

On topics listed above

**Experience:** Minimum of 60 hours of flight training as per Transport Canada

Training shall include:

37 hours dual flight instruction including:

Minimum of 5 hours of cross-country flight time

Minimum of 10 hours of instrument training (5 may be used from Fixed wing license)

23 hours solo flight time including:

Minimum of 10 hours of cross-country flight time with the cross country of not less than 2 hours flight time from the point of departure with 3 full stop landing at points other than the point of departure.

Pass a flight test off approximately 1.5 hours. Transport Canada flight test will test both your flight maneuvers and your knowledge on the ground.
