



# Private Pilot License Alternate Category

**Must be a licensed commercial or private fixed wing pilot**

## Transport Canada Minimum Requirement

Age:	14 Minimum. It is recommended that the student be at least 16 must be 17 at issuance
Medical Fitness:	Category 1 or 3
Knowledge:	20 hours of Ground School

## Topics Include

Canadian Air Regulations  
Theory of Flight and aerodynamics  
Airframes, Engines and Aircraft Systems  
Flight Instruments  
Flight Operations

Obtain a mark of 60% on the Transport Canada written examination of 30 questions. (PHRAC)

On topics listed above

**Experience:** Minimum of 30 hours of flight training as per Transport Canada

Training shall include:

17 hours dual flight instruction including:

Minimum of 3 hours of cross-country flight time

Minimum of 5 hours of instrument training (may be brought forward as credits from fixed wing license)

12 hours solo flight time including:

Minimum of 3 hours of cross-country flight time with the cross country of not less than 100 nautical miles from the point of departure with 2 full stop landing at points other than the point of departure.

Pass a flight test off approximately 1.5 hours. Transport Canada flight test will test both your flight maneuvers and your knowledge on the ground.
